## Definition of Part-time

Part-time is anything less than 40 hours per week. Half-time is 20 hours per week.

## Benefits

Part-time postdocs are entitled to the same medical benefits as full-time postdocs. The Principal Investigator/department is still required to pay for single coverage regardless of whether the postdoc is full or part time -- and regardless of how many hours the postdoc works per week.

## Sick and Vacation Time

Postdocs who work half-time or more, should receive the same amount of vacation and sick days per year. Anything less than half-time is prorated based on (FTE) the percentage of effort. Example: A postdoc that works $40 \%$ effort per week ( 16 hours) should get $40 \%$ of the sick and vacation time.
