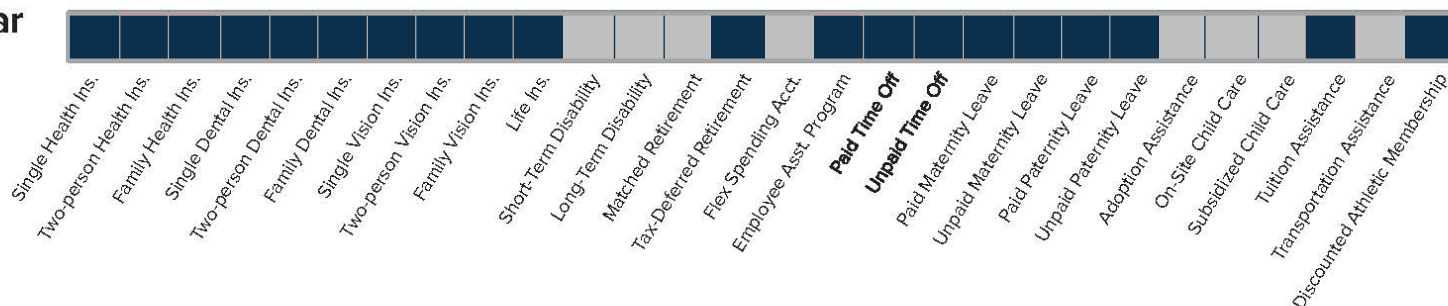

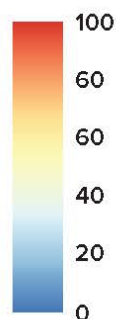

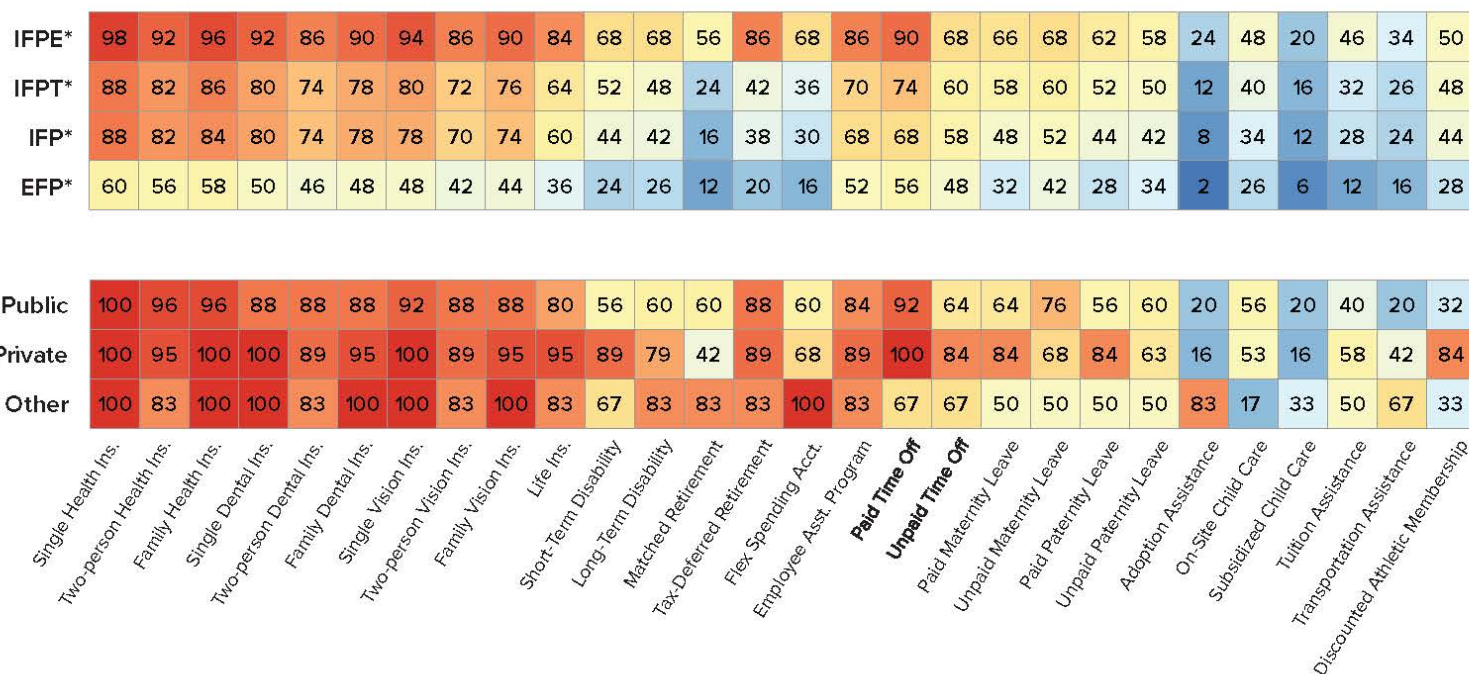

Institutionally Funded Postdoc Employees (IFPE): the classification(s) an institution typically uses for a postdoc employed by the institution and usually funded on a principal investigator's research grant (for example, an NIH R01 grant).
Institutionally Funded Postdoc Trainees (IFPT): the classification(s) an institution typically uses for a postdoc funded on a principal investigator's training grant (for example, an NIH T32 grant) but who is not considered an employee of the institution.
Individually Funded Postdocs (IFP): the classification(s) an institution typically uses for a postdoc funded by a fellowship that is paid to the institution (such as an NIH National Research Service Award).
Externally Funded Postdocs (EFP): the classification(s) an institution typically uses for a postdoc funded by a fellowship that is paid directly to the postdoc (such as a fellowship from a foreign country).
