- Felicia Moss: Director, Postdoctoral Affairs:

 - Annual Vendor Fair was organized successfully by PDA on March 1st from 10 − 1:30 pm at Wolstein Research Center.
 - 23 vendors participated and \$5,250 was collected. \$ 1,100 were spent as part of the event organizing expenses.

 - Addressing concerns around lacking support for some old versions of Windows such as Windows XP.
 - Teaching technologies-How are we supporting the use of updated modes of teaching?
 - What benchmarks and comparators are we using to understand our classroom/teaching and learning technologies?
 - What is the plan for rolling out **Microsoft 2022**?
 - In addition, discussion was also held regarding **Onedrive** automatic backup and potential ways to address future changes in cost structure in our shared/storage.

They have an application process to safeguard access to the data, plus levels of access depending upon the sensitivity of the data."
