Benefits Committee, Bernadette Schneider

- Transportation survey:
 - About 40 people responded, Last question would you support a vote for joining RTA group benefits with a monthly fee for RTA passes for all postdocs?
 - 30% support, ~²/₃ said no, some strong comments against
 - A moderate fraction of the responses do take public transportation
 - Encouraged them to take advantage of the pre-tax RTA pass option
 - Point discussed
 - Can Safe Ride be expanded?

- Or can there be designated shuttles to specific neighborhoods?
 - o Fairhill, Shaker Square, MetroHealth
- o Is this a thing to ask facilities/campus planning committee?
 - o Eric will ask if this is within the scope of the committee
- Learned about a CWRU rideshare initiative CarShare, Hourly car rental capabilities
- Childcare subsidy
 - Things are in the works, still confirming who is eligible and what makes someone ineligible
 - Felicia is the point person for postdocs when it comes to this subsidy
 - There will be childcare discounts: Percentage discounts, annual enrollment covered
 - The application to request the subsidy is still in progress
 - There are funds for childcare during travel
 - o Child 18 or under
 - Postdocs eligible for ~\$1500 childcare subsidy
 - o Apply April 1 May 15
 - o Must be in position for 1 year before July 1 each year
 - o Spouse must either: work full time, be enrolled in a full-time degree program, or be disabled
 - o Postdocs must be full-time (staff just need to be part-time)
 - o Child must be 6 years of age or younger
 - Things are still being finalized and figured out
