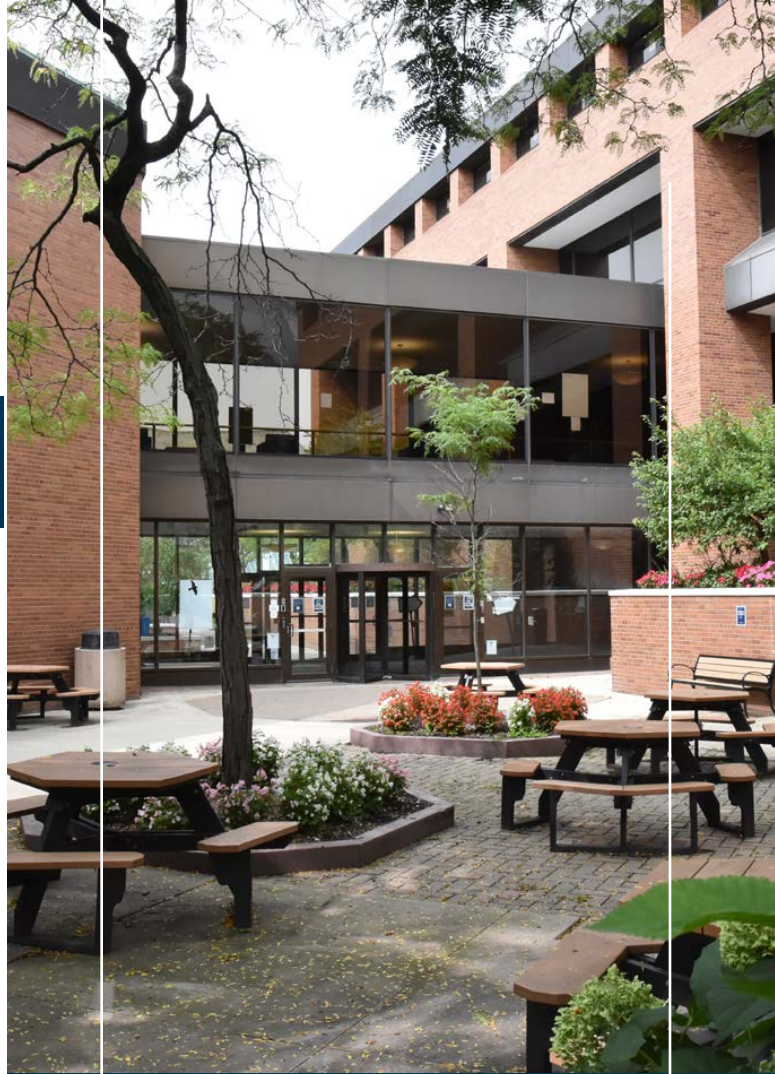

Hiring Process

The hiring process for police positions includes a physical agility test, an oral board interview, background investigation and medical and psychological exam. OPOTA certification required at time of hire.

Police Officer Transitional Allowance Program

Candidates who have graduated from an Ohio police academy within the last year may be eligible for a \$2500 transitional allowance to assist with the cost of police academy attendance.
