How to Download

1. Download "Rave Guardian" from the iPhone App Store or Google Play.
2. Enter your mobile phone number and your CWRU email address, using the @case.edu domain in the address.
3. Fill in your profile information (only fields marked with * are required).
4. Explore the app!



Please note: All information will remain strictly confidential. Police or first responders will only access your information when you request assistance.

The Case Western Reserve University Division of Public Safety has partnered with Rave Mobile Safety to offer Rave Guardian, an award-winning mobile safety

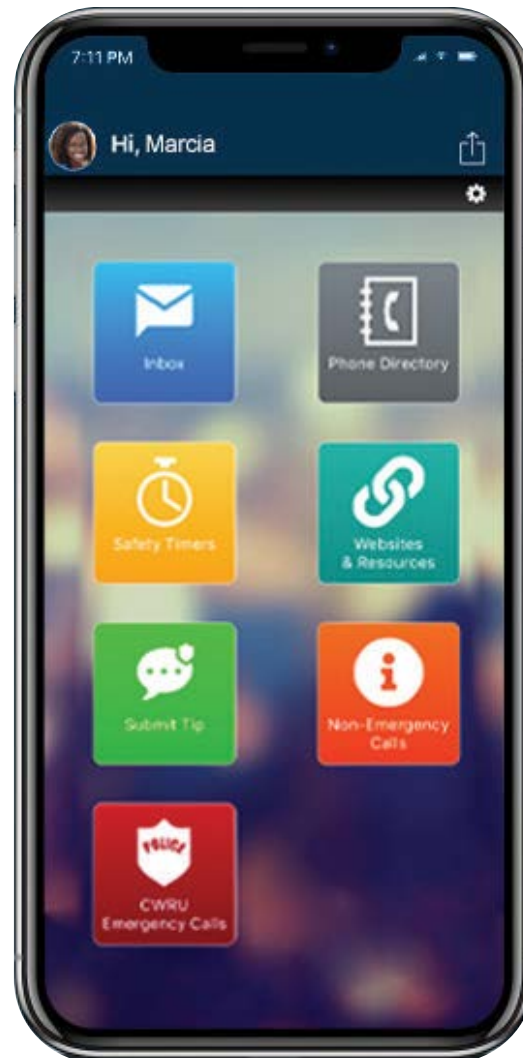
app offering easy access to the help and resources you need most.

Key Features

Never Walk Alone

Add friends, family or public safety officials as “Guardians” for an extra layer of safety when walking alone. Simply set a timer for your trip with your destination—your “Guardian” can track your progress in real time and will be alerted if you do not deactivate the timer.

Discreetly Contact Campus Police

Prevent dangerous situations by discreetly sending anonymous tips concerning suspicious behavior, unsafe situations, crimes and other hazards. This feature allows you to chat with campus safety officials without drawing attention from those around you.

Instant Location Sharing and Streaming

With one tap, you can share your location with public safety for a faster response.

Find the Resources You Need

Access emergency procedures, important websites and other key documents in our website and resource directory.

Stay Informed

Receive alerts based on your location, even when you don’t have a cell signal.

Make the Right Call

Easily find assistance and resources with a directory of important university numbers.
