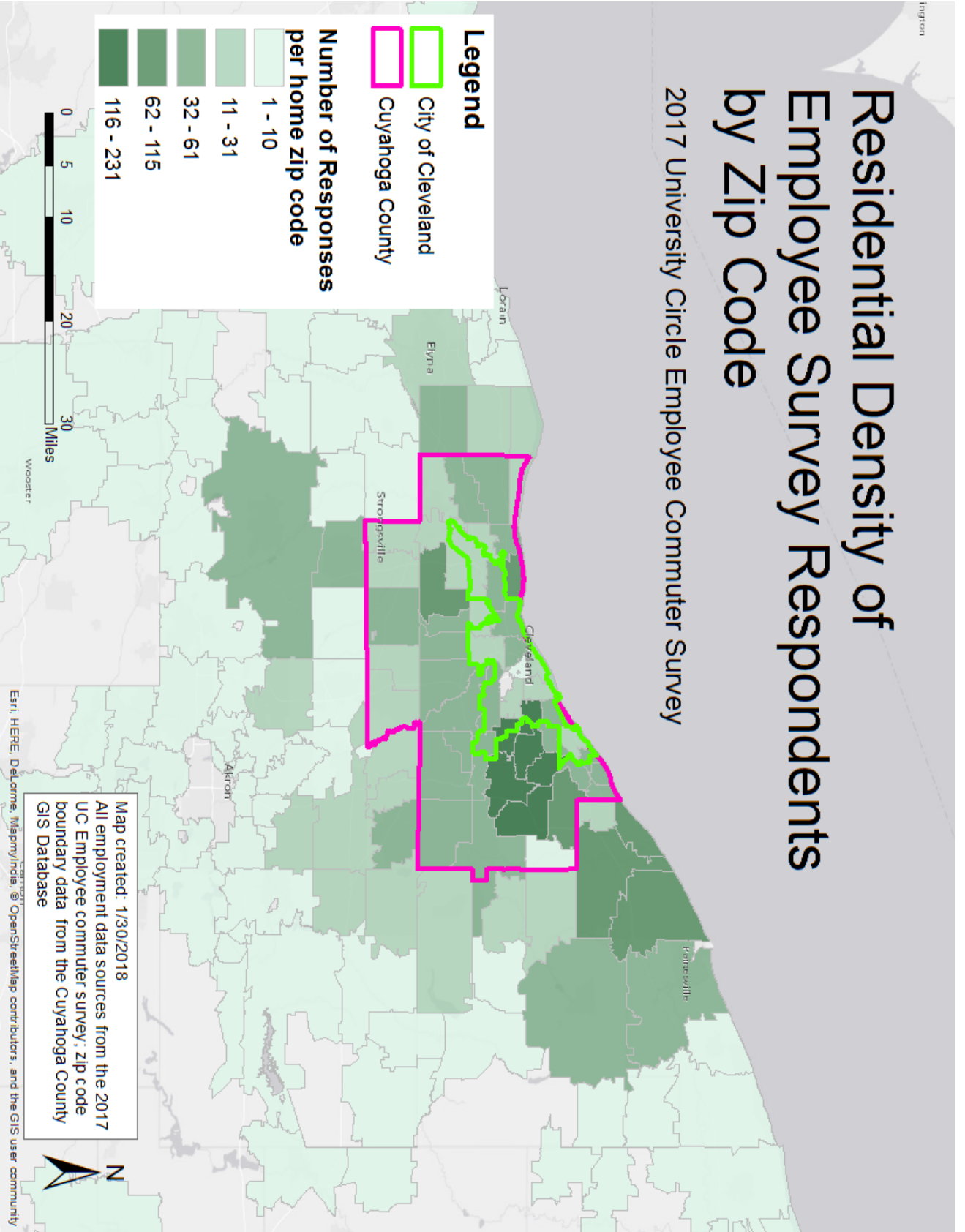

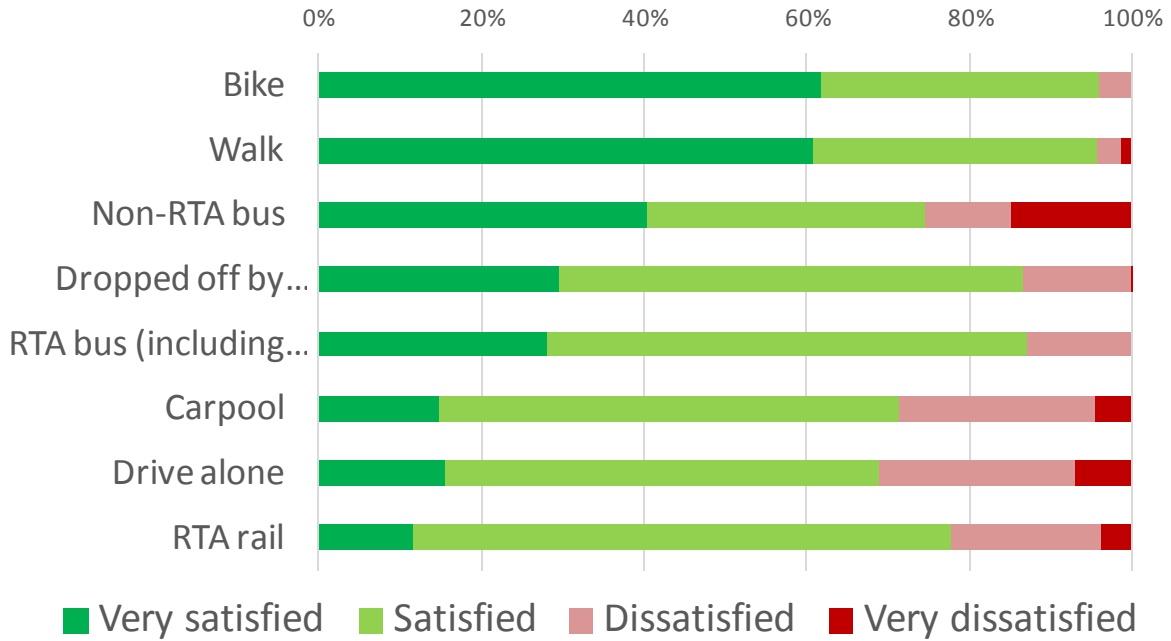

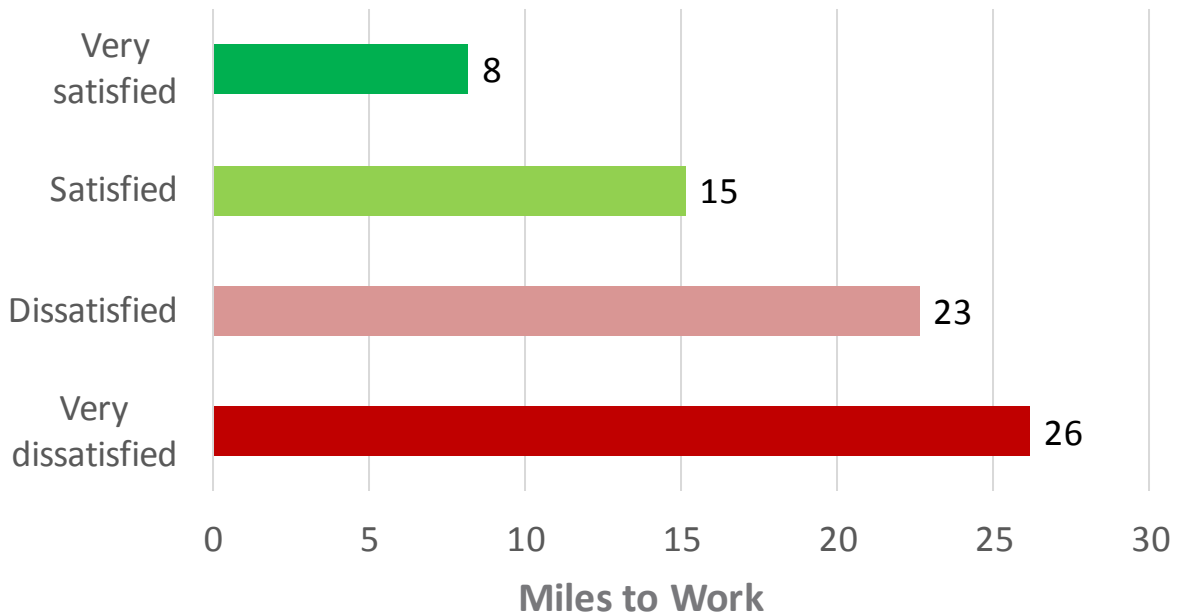

Commuter Satisfaction by Distance to Work



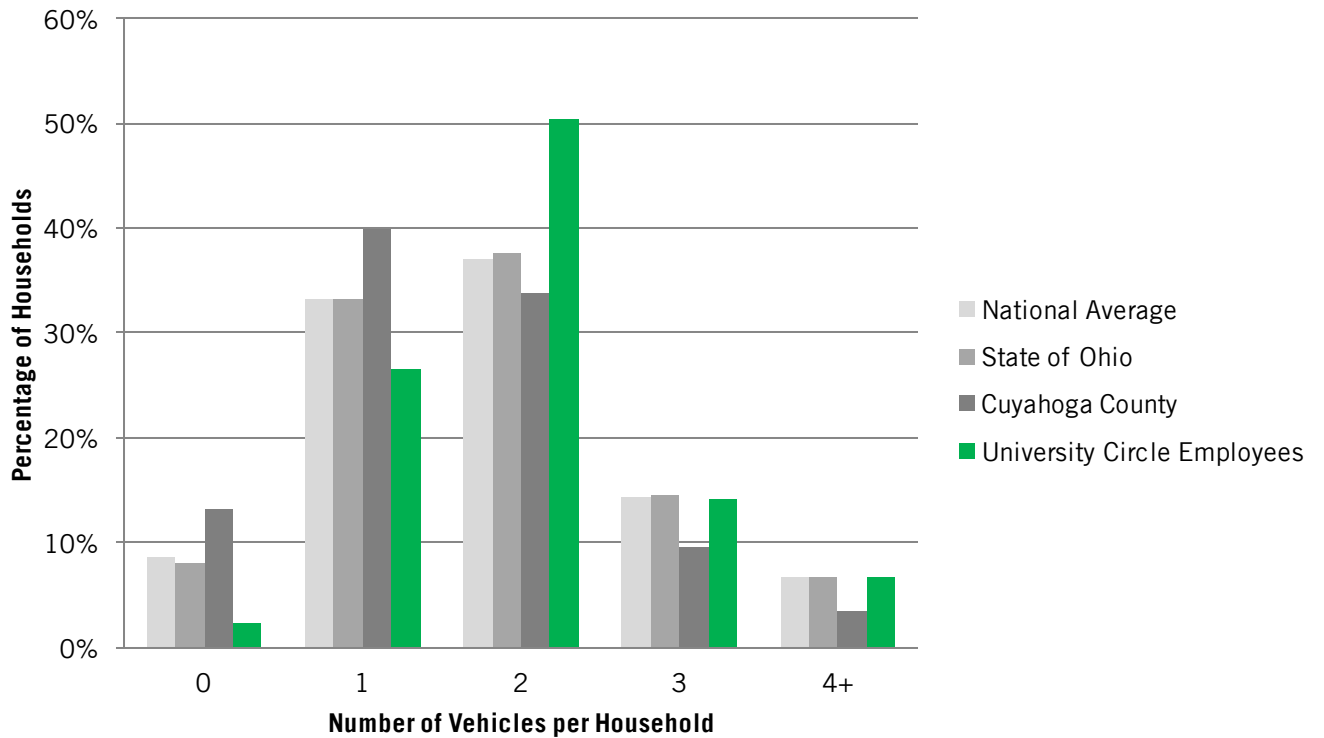

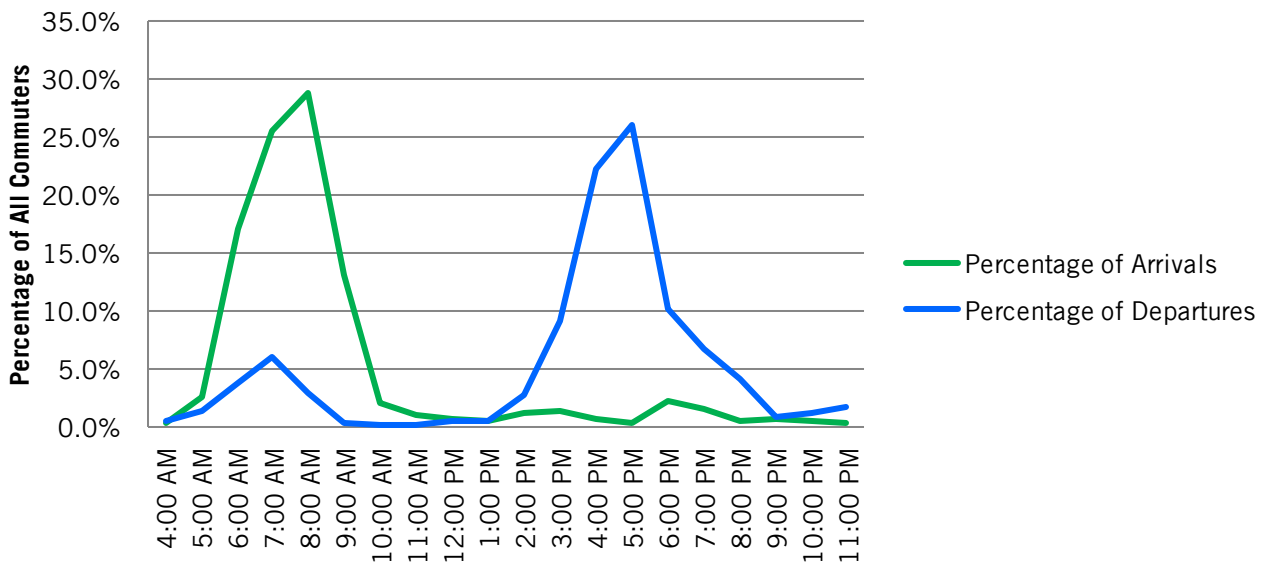
