**Nursing's Susan Painter offers intentional support to combat unintentional overdoses.** She's now working on several fronts to help fortify families as well as current and future providers against the pain and stigma of losing loved ones and patients to overdoses.

She is developing curriculum for undergraduates and graduate students at CWRU, giving presentations to local, state and national organizations about substance-use disorders. She is also working with colleagues at CWRU's **Ohio Substance Use Disorders Center of Excellence** to develop educational resources and training content for providers throughout the state to address well-being and recovery as the overdose and addiction crisis continues to take lives.

Painter recently spoke with **Think** about caring for people amid their anguish.

#### **OD2A Conference at Atlanta**

Michelle Riske-Morris and Sarah Fulton traveled to Atlanta in early July for the national conference for the CDC Overdose to Action (OD2A) grant program sponsored by the CDC. The event highlighted how sites across the nation are using surveillance data to identify areas in most need of harm reduction and treatment services in response to the opioid and stimulant overdose crisis. Michelle and Sarah presented on two different panels showcasing the efforts in Cuyahoga County to utilize OD2A funding to support the building and strengthening of local collaborations. These partnerships work together to identify areas in greatest need, as well as expand access to harm reduction, education and treatment services across the broader region.
