
Transformative global education

Nicaragua: Summer 2019

Child Development/Child Welfare | SASS 575

3 Credits



Participants who are students from any university are permitted to attend this program. This three credit Mandel School Study Abroad course to Nicaragua will focus on substantive study in either child development / health or child welfare. It will provide students the opportunity to acquire or strengthen their knowledge of the Spanish language and Nicaraguan culture. The course will be taught using a combination of lectures and individual and group exercise, including a sizeable service learning component. Along with lectures from Mandel School and local faculty, students will visit agencies that provide services to children and families in Granada, Nicaragua, participate in service learning projects, and meet with Nicaraguan professionals. They will also learn the country 's social, political, and economic issues, as well as its history and culture.

Note: Non-CWRU students & alums pay \$600 administrative fee.


