Faculty Biographical Sketch

David E. Biegel is the Henry L. Zucker Professor of Social Work Practice and Professor of Psychiatry and Sociology at the Mandel School of Applied Social Sciences, Case Western Reserve University. He serves as the Chair of the Doctoral Program. Dr. Biegel is a Fellow of the Academy of Social Work and Social Welfare and also a Fellow of the Gerontological Society of America. He has been involved in research pertaining to the impact of chronic illnesses and developmental disorders on families for the past several decades. Dr. Biegel is the author of over one hundred thirty publications principally focused on family caregiving with a variety of populations including adolescents and young adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders, frail elderly individuals, persons with severe and persistent mental illness, and individuals with co-occurring mental and substance use disorders. He currently serves as lead editor of the Evidence-Based Practices Series published by Oxford University Press in cooperation with the Jack, Joseph and Morton Mandel School of Applied Social Services.
