Individual Research Practicum Study Agreement

With instructor and research sequence chair written approval, an individual program of supervised research experience may be undertaken. This course allows the student to tailor a program of applied research to a specific practice issue or program. The prerequisites are Social Work Methods (SASS 477 Field Education I (SASS 601), and Introduction to Social Research (SASS 426). An Individual Research Practicum (SASS 536) (3 credit hours) must involve the student in an active role on an actual research application in order to satisfy the requirement for an advanced research elective. The nature of the research project, assignments, and readings are to be agreed upon by the instructor and the student.

This form must be completed whenever a student makes arrangements with an instructor to do an Individual Research Practicum. It is the responsibility of the student to complete this form, have it signed by the instructor and to return it to the Office of Student Services at the time of (pre) registration. No credit will be given for the course and it will not appear on the student's transcript, unless this form is completed.
