Brian Schreiber joined the Jewish Community Center (JCC) of Greater Pittsburgh in 1999 as President & CEO and oversees this community benefit organization serving nearly 35,000 individuals in the region.

Prior work experience includes Annual Fund Director at the Pittsburgh Jewish Federation; community service worker for *Sherut L'Am* in Ashkelon, Israel; and Field Examiner for the National Labor Relations Board in Newark, NJ.

Schreiber served six years on the board of the Jewish Community Center Association of North America and currently acts as a consultant and special advisor to its President. He served two years as Advisory Board Chair of the Greater Pittsburgh Nonprofit Partnership and is a current board member of Standing Firm: The Business Case to End Gender Violence. Earlier volunteer experiences include suicide/crisis intervention specialist for *Contact Pittsburgh* and Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Baltimore. He was also a member of a special task force that developed the 10 27 Healing Partnership, a resiliency center serving community victims after the shooting at the Tree of Life facility in 2018.

Schreiber is a Licensed Social Worker and a credited Field Instructor through the University Of Pittsburgh School of Social Work. He received a B.A. in Economics/Business and History from Lafayette College, a Master of Social Work from the University of Maryland and a Masters in Jewish Studies from Baltimore Hebrew University.
