## What is a microaggression?

Intentional or unintentional, subtle, verbal or non-verbal behaviors or actions. They degrade or demean a specific group and they are often unacknowledged

GENDER	<ul> <li>Microassault – Deliberate         <ul> <li>"That's so gay!"</li> </ul> </li> <li>Microinsult – Conscious         <ul> <li>Seeking input from only men during a workplace meeting.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Micro invalidation – Unconscious         <ul> <li>"You're prettier when you smile"</li> </ul> </li> <li>Sexual objectification and assumptions of traditional gender roles or inferiority.</li> </ul>
LGBTQ	<ul> <li>Microassault – Deliberate         <ul> <li>"You don't look gay"</li> </ul> </li> <li>Microinsult – Conscious         <ul> <li>Refusal of the use of pronouns</li> </ul> </li> <li>Micro invalidation – Unconscious         <ul> <li>Categorizing one's sexuality or gender identity as a phase.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Using transphobic or heterosexist terminology and discomfort of the LGBTQ experience.</li> </ul>
RELIGIOUS	<ul> <li>Microassault – Deliberate         <ul> <li>Referring to God in a profane manner</li> </ul> </li> <li>Microinsult – Conscious         <ul> <li>If you're Latino, you must be catholic."</li> </ul> </li> <li>Micro invalidation – Unconscious         <ul> <li>Telling someone you disapprove of that God "loves the sinner but hates the sin."</li> </ul> </li> <li>Stereotypes based on religion and religious groups</li> </ul>
INTERSECTIONAL	<ul> <li>A Latina woman may experience intersectional microaggressions based on her race and gender.</li> <li>A LGBTQ person of color may experience intersectional microaggressions based on their sexual identity and race.</li> <li>Multiple groups can influence the intensity of the microaggression.</li> </ul>
