



## NOTICE OF INTENT TO PURSUE THE GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN DATA SCIENCE FOR SOCIAL IMPACT

**Admission Requirements:**

The Certificate in Data Sciences for Social Impact is geared towards degree-seeking students in graduate programs at CWRU and non-degree students interested in earning a credential in data science. A total of 12 credit hours is required to earn the DSSI certificate; it can be completed on-campus in 1.5 years.

**Prerequisites:**

The DSSI curriculum is open to all students enrolled in a graduate program at CWRU who have taken an introductory statistics class. Students must earn a minimum GPA of 3.00 for the digital credential to be awarded. This is not a transcriptable certificate.
