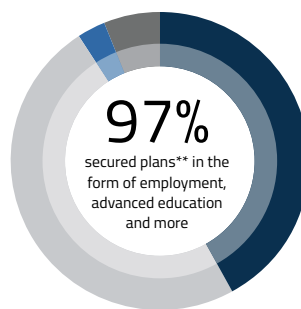
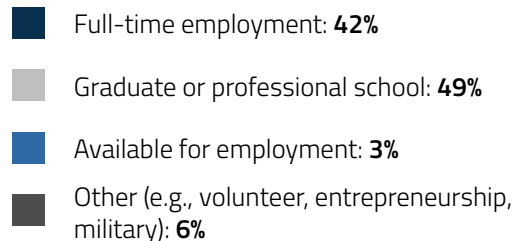

## Primary Plans

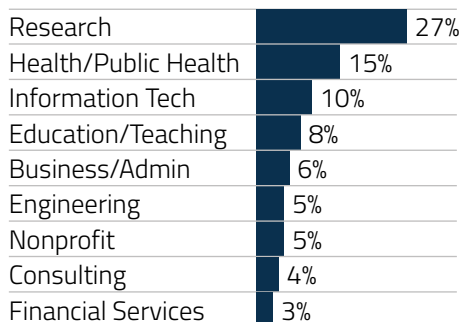
More arts and sciences graduates pursued advanced degrees than entered the workforce:

Starting salaries for graduates saw a year-over-year increase of \$5,000:

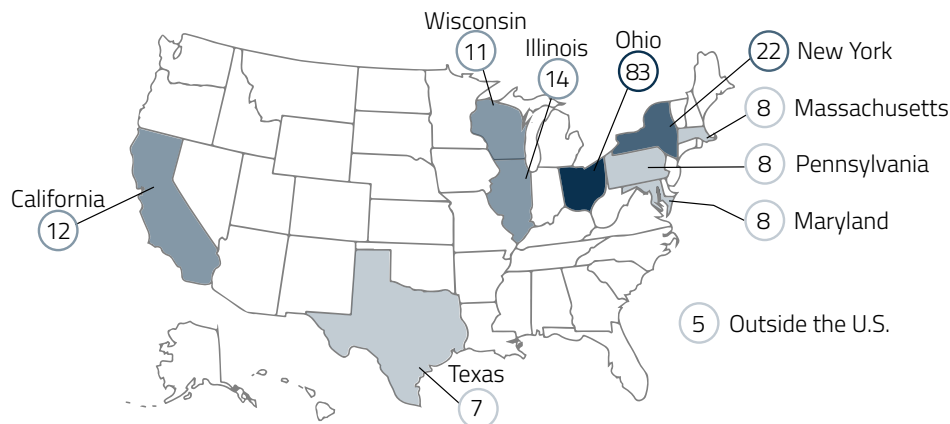

Graduates secured positions at top firms in sought-after job markets in the U.S. and globally. Destinations with 5 or more graduates include:



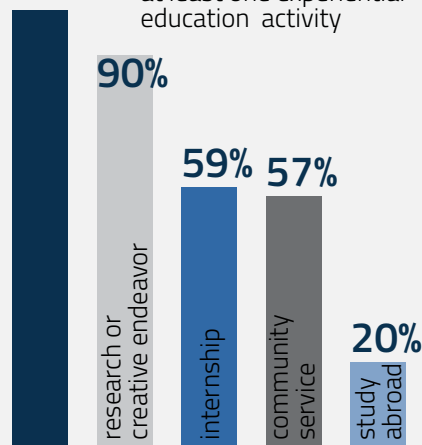

**97%** of respondents indicated that they participated in at least one experiential education activity

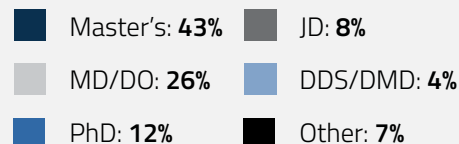
