

## **Primary Plans**

The percentage of engineering graduates entering the workforce increased 19% over 2021:

- Full-time employment: **69**%
- Graduate or professional school: 27%
- Available for employment: **3%**
- Other (e.g., volunteer, entrepreneurship, military): **2%**


