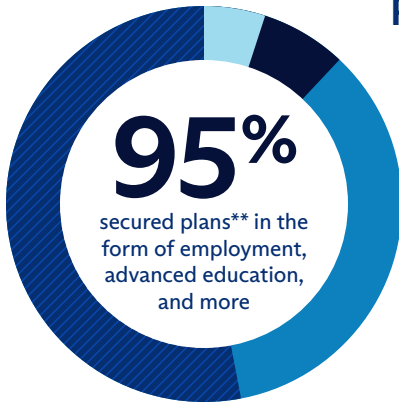

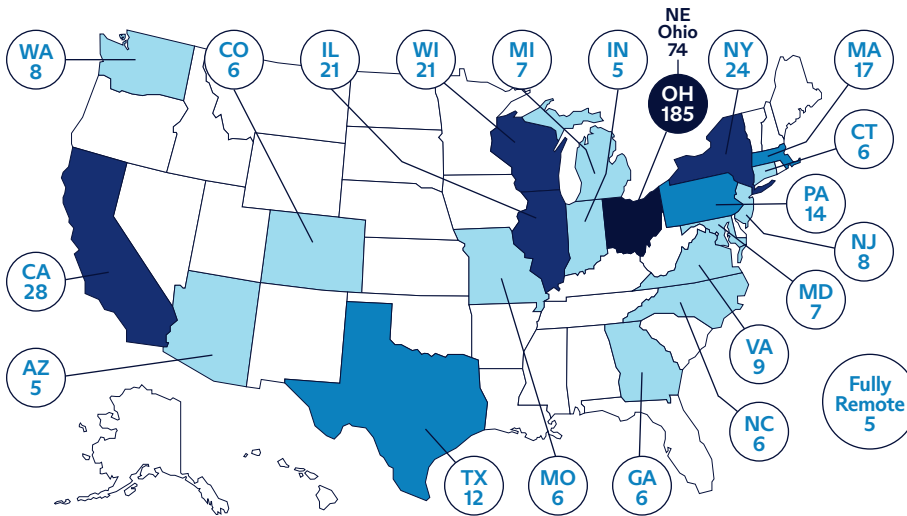


Primary Plans after Graduation

Employment Details

2025 graduates entering the workforce reported starting salaries consistent with last year’s record high.

Median Salary Range: **\$75,000-79,999[†]**

19% of reported positions had salaries **> \$100,000**

89% of positions required a Bachelor's degree

79% of positions required a degree and were major-related

This includes the survey response rate plus additional information gathered from faculty, social media and other sources.

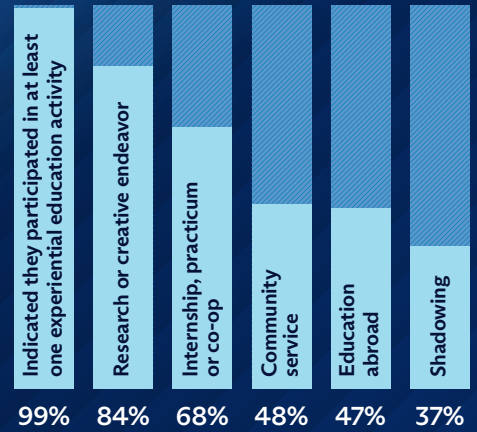

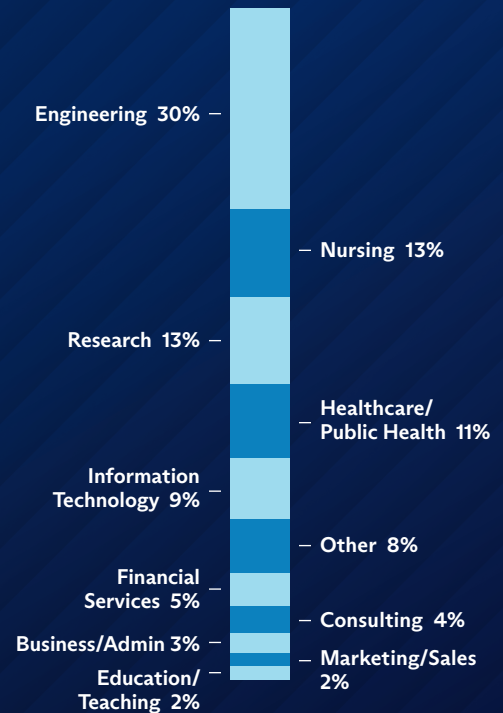

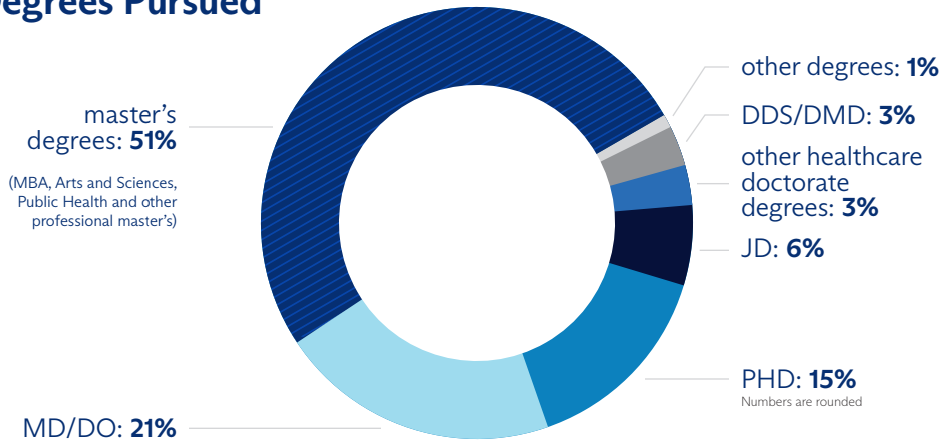
