NEIGHBORHOOD PETS OUTREACH AND RESOURCE CENTER

From Tinkham Veale University Center: 17 min drive, 1 hr 49 min walk, 46 min transit Provides affordable pet supplies, a pet food pantry, low-cost flea prevention and dewormer, low-cost vaccine clinics, free ID tags and gently used collars/leashes, free spay/neuter for dogs and cats, medical assistance funding for emergency medical cases, euthanasia services for clients who are unable to afford the cost, and counseling, information, and resource referrals. Everyone, regardless of residency or income, is welcome to shop for supplies. Dewormer and flea prevention are available to non-members at a slightly higher, but still affordable price. To qualify, must live in Cleveland or East Cleveland and have a total household income less than 150% of the federal poverty guidelines. If you qualify, stop in to sign-up and bring photo ID and proof of address. Walkin Hours are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12pm to 4pm and Saturdays 10am to 2pm at 3711 E 65th Street Cleveland OH 44105. The Jake Brady Memorial Fund is dedicated to providing funding for corrective, suitable, and life-saving medical treatment for companion animals of families in need. Fund recipients of companion animals include senior citizens and retirees on fixed income, low income families with documentated annual incomes of less than \$18,000 per year, physically and/or mentally impaired, or unemployed and/or receiving government assistance. VALLEY SAVE-A-PET

Offers cat and dog spay/neuter at a discounted rate for pet owners who otherwise cannot afford the cost. Modest additional charges are required for all animals not current on vaccinations and for large dogs whose weight might require special anesthesia. Financial help is also provided to owners who cannot afford the cost of emergency veterinary care for their pets. Calling our call center will provide you with further details. Our lines will be open on Mondays and Wednesdays from 11:00am to 2:00pm and the first Saturday of each month at 440.232.2287.

FREE RX PLUS - PET MEDICATION

The Free RX Plus Discount Drug Card provides you free access to savings up to 85% on your medications if you are uninsured, underinsured, or even if you have insurance and have a co-pay of \$10 or more. This card can be used to save on your pet's prescriptions by asking the veterinarian to prescribe the human equivalent of the medication and use our card to receive savings up to 85% on generic medications and up to 20% on brand medications. THE MOSBY FOUNDATION



Provides financial assistance to dog owners in need of medical and non-routine medical expenses nationwide. Do not assist with diagnostics, testing, CT scans, or x-rays; general and/or routine veterinary care (such as vaccinations, office visits, blood work, testing, dental cleanings); or treatment that has already been performed. It is also a requirement that all dogs we help be spayed/neutered prior to our providing financial assistance. We are not equipped to respond to emergency situations. MAGIC BULLET FUND

The Magic Bullet Fund provides financial assistance for cats and dogs with cancer. Assistance is for cancer treatment including surgery or chemotherapy only. Generally, there is a 1-week to 2-week waiting time after we have received your application and all financial information. We need last tax year 1040 and last month bank statement. LIVE LIKE ROO FOUNDATION



The Live Like Roo Foundation provides financial assistance to help cover healthcare costs related to cancer treatment in the form of grants. This program offers grants ranging from \$500 to \$1500 per qualified applicant and are awarded on a monthly basis after a complete review of the application and the relevant medical records.
