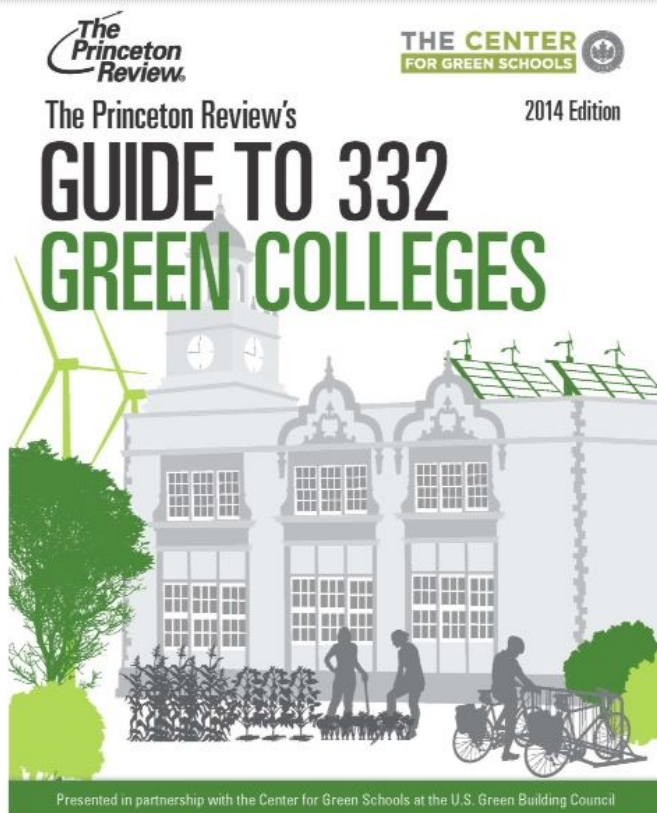

The 411 on Recycling E-waste @ CWRU

Do you have an old computer, printer, keyboard, phone, technology power cords, etc. collecting dust in your office? If you are a member of the CWRU staff or faculty, you can request a free door-side pick-up of your E-waste by filling out this [request form](#) (there is a charge for TVs). Students can take small E-waste items like cell phones, batteries, or printer ink cartridges to the E-waste receptacles in Wade Commons and Fribley.
