
- Formerly, two separate rideshare/carpool platforms in the state: OhioRideshare & RideshareOhio



- Gohio Commute combines trip planning and ride matching features into one convenient tool that incentivizes smart commutes
- One-stop-shop trip planner, Point A to Point B, with multimodal options
- Interactive maps show the routes and allow users to find carpool, vanpool, and bike pool matches

- Improved public health




How does Gohio Commute encourage alternative commutes?






Sample commute from Lakewood to NOACA








