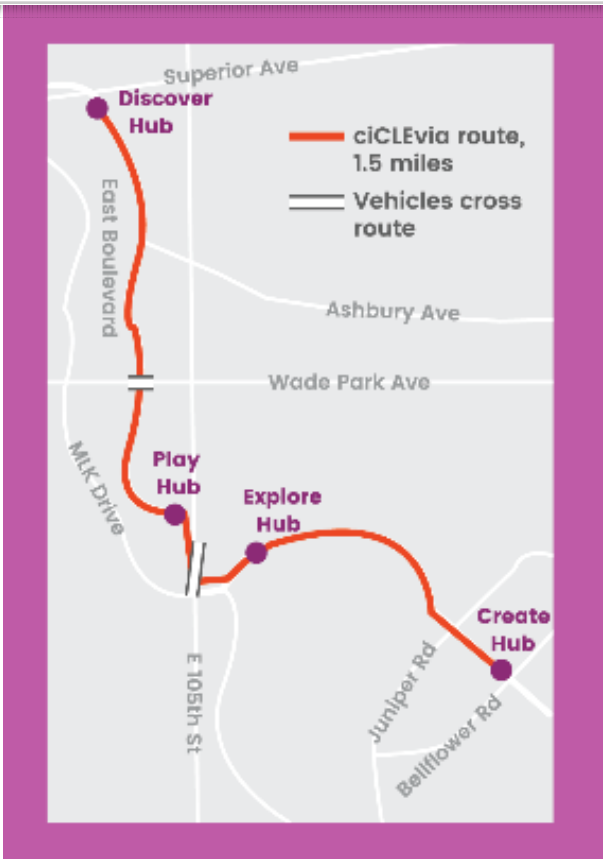


Campus Garden

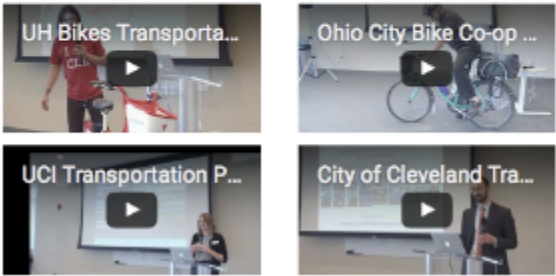
