What are you offering the community?

My vision for food justice helps Central residents who have been excluded from economic and educational opportunities due to their abilities or history, who need better access to sustainable work and quality food, by creating a vocational community farm and focusing on employing, educating, and feeding the surrounding communities.



Why is this needed?

There is a lack of quality food access. The Central community does not have a grocery store. This affects the health and overall well-being of the residents. Some residents in Central have experienced circumstances that limit the potential of sustainable employment, which creates the domino effect of not being able to provide nourishment for the home and for themselves.



What's happening with this work in the next 6-12 months? I am participating in the Dig In Training.

I will apply for plots of land through the Cleveland Land Bank by September.

Summer Sprout will test the soil on my plots.

I will take Summer Sprout classes.

We will start setting up the farm next winter/spring.

Fall 2023: Canvassing community of 38th-39th Street to see if residents support this vision and what benefits I can offer them from the farm.
