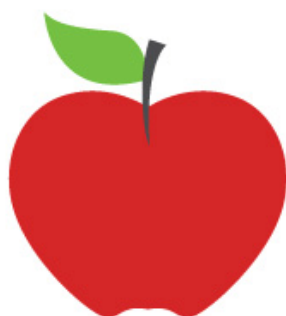

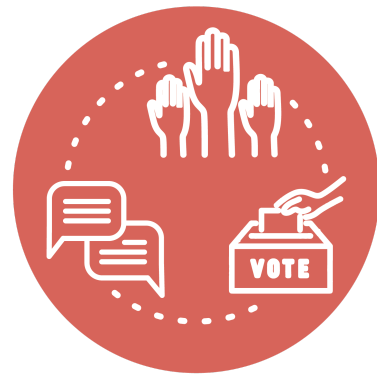
Building Capacity for Obesity Prevention
