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Conditions of Visiting Student Summer Enrollment

1. Visiting students are subject to policies outlined in the Case Western Reserve University Bulletin and Handbook (including registration dates, class withdrawal, academic integrity, etc.). 2. A student enrolled in summer classes who wishes to enter a degree program must file an application for admission as a degree candidate. Acceptance as a summer visiting student does not obligate Case Western Reserve to accept the student as a degree candidate.
3. Students who wish to enroll at Case Western Reserve as a visiting student in a fall or spring semester must complete a Visiting Student Application. Visiting students may enroll in a maximum of 30 credits distributed among no more than five semesters as long as a "C" grade point average is maintained.
4. Credit for course work taken at Case Western Reserve may or may not transfer to or be accepted by a home institution. Please confer with the appropriate official at your home institution if you have questions about the applicability of transfer credit.

In applying for admission as a visiting student, I certify that all the information on this application is correct to the best of my knowledge; that I have read and understand the conditions stated above; and that if accepted as a summer visiting student at Case Western Reserve University, I agree that during such time as I may be enrolled I will abide by all the rules, regulations, practices and policies of Case Western Reserve University as they may be at the time of admission or as they may be changed during my period of enrollment at Case Western Reserve University.
