Instruction Modes Defined

In Person, Traditional - Courses in which instructional contact hours for each student are delivered in-person or courses in which directed study occurs as arranged (e.g., independent study, research courses, dissertation, etc.).

Added for Fall 2020 and Spring 2021:

Blended (Emergency) - Courses normally taught in person, but due to emergency, in-person instructional contact hours for each student are reduced and supplemented with remote (synchronous and/or asynchronous) instruction.

Instruction Modes Defined

Remote-Asynchronous (Emergency) - Courses normally taught in person, but due to emergency, instructional contact hours for each student are delivered in 100% asynchronous remote format. There will be no specific meeting days and times; students view recorded material on their own schedule.

Remote-Synchronous (Emergency) - Courses normally taught in person, but due to emergency, instructional contact hours for each student are delivered in 100% remote format, with the majority delivered synchronously. Students are expected to attend synchronous meetings at designated days and times.

Spring 2021: Who will be living on campus?

Up to 2500 students

Those students living on campus this fall may stay

First-year international students who could not get here for fall

New first-year and transfer students may live on campus

Others by lottery

Exceptions process

The Spring 2021 January Session

Three week, remote course offering only:

- Jan 8: January Session start date
- Jan 12: Drop/add deadline
- Jan 18: MLK Day Holiday, no classes
- Jan 29: Last day of January session, course withdrawal and P/NP deadline

This is an option for students.

Students limited to 4 credit-hours.

No student should be required to be enrolled for the January Session.

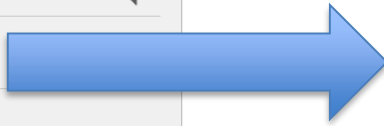

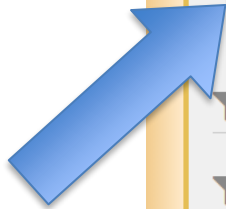
