










With 9,949 square feet, this venue can host up to 750 guests in a lecture setup or 400 for a banquet.

The air walls divide the space into three separate breakout rooms, offering flexibility and costefficiency.

The floor-to-ceiling windows provide breathtaking views of the Cleveland skyline.




The Senior Classroom

At 1,285 square feet, this contemporary meeting area can be split into two distinct rooms, accommodating between 10 and up to 100 people. Each room has integrated monitors and conferencing tools for smooth presentations.

Featuring floor-to-ceiling windows that provide a view of the sculpture garden and Guilford House, creating a vibrant ambiance. The room also offers frosted film on the glass entrance and window shades, making it ideal for public and confidential meetings.



First and Second Floor Conference Rooms



At just under 400 square feet, these modern meeting rooms can accommodate between 5-25 people.

Student Organization Center


This 2,131-square-foot multipurpose room is located on the first floor of the University Center and offers flexibility for various setup options. It can accommodate 30-100 people.

The room features an 82" television for presentations, along with several whiteboards. Floor-to-ceiling windows on three sides provide stunning views of the East Bell Commons and Nord Family Greenway, and automated window shades are on the south and west sides.

With a variety of laptops, AV equipment, staging, and lighting available for rent, the University Center has all the tools to create a captivating and memorable event that meets your audiovisual needs.






PARKING

While parking is not included in the event cost, our team collaborates with Parking Services, valet providers, and the Department of Public Safety to offer convenient parking and transportation options for your event.








- Efficient temperature control with doubleskin glass curtain wall and automated window shades
- Green roof for insulation, stormwater management, and natural integration
- Rooftop photovoltaic panels for renewable energy
- Radiant floors, chilled beams, and an "air curtain" system for efficient heating and cooling
- Sustainable materials with recycled content and regional sourcing
- Promotion of alternative transportation

The center houses Bon Appétit, a leader in responsible dining, supporting local producers, reducing waste through composting and food recovery, and committing to the Real Food Challenge. CWRU's food pulper turns waste into compost for the University Farm.
