





Procedure


To view the accessible course videos within the MediaVision Courseware system, log in to blackboard.case.edu with your CWRU Network ID and password.




Step	Action
1.	To begin, click on the course name link that includes the video you wish to review.
2.	Click the MediaVision link from the bottom, left side of the menu. 




Step	Action
3.	<p>The MediaVision work area will appear.</p> <div data-bbox="342 1293 505 1335" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 2px; display: inline-block;">MediaVision</div> <p>Note: The Course Bookmarks section contains all the bookmark links for any video assigned to the course. Bookmarks allow students to return to a specific section of the video and make notes or review that segment.</p>





4.	The Course Echoes section contains the list of videos assigned to the particular class. 





Step	Action
5.	<p>To choose a video, click on the video name from the list shown on the left.</p> <p>Note: You can use the tabs that appear on the right to access additional options for the video selected.</p>




Step	Action
6.	<p>There are three tabs available for each video.</p> <p>Information tab: Shows the duration of the video, a short description of the material (if one was provided) and an associated picture.</p> 




Step	Action
7.	<p>Discussions tab: Contains discussion threads created by students and instructors that apply to the video content.</p> <p>Click on the discussion entry to navigate to the corresponding section of the video. You can also insert replies or address additional topics by creating new discussions.</p> 




Step	Action
8.	<p>Bookmark tab: Lists all the points in the video for which a bookmark link or “short cut” was created. After clicking on a bookmark, the video will move to the designated section and then restart.</p> 
9.	<p>To play the video, click the Play button.</p> 






10.	<p>A new dialog box will open that contains the video feed and viewing tips. To start the video, click the Play button.</p> <div data-bbox="328 1360 435 1430" data-label="Image"> </div> <p>Note: It may take several minutes for the video to load.</p>





11.	<p>The video player interface will open.</p> <p>Note: The view appearing on the left will vary depending on how/what the instructor has recorded. In this example, the instructor has recorded a video and his computer screen.</p>





Step	Action
12.	<p>The right side of the player interface includes a menu.</p> <p>To place a bookmark at this point, click the player pause icon  and then click the Bookmarks menu item.</p> 






13.	In the white space (Add bookmark) "Type your bookmark name" .
14.	Click the Submit button. 




Step	Action
15.	The new bookmark will now be available to select from the bookmark list. 
16.	Click the Applications button to return to the main menu. 





17.	Click the Discussions menu item. 





18.	To start a discussion, click the Create New Discussion button. 



19.	Type the title of the discussion thread into the Title field. Enter the comments for the discussion thread in the Message field.
20.	Click the Submit button.

21.	Click the DELETE link on a thread or reply to delete it from the list. 
22.	Click the Applications button to return the main menu. 
23.	To return to the MediaVision Echo Center, click the icon appearing next to the video title.

24.	To view the discussions or bookmarks that were created, click on the tabs for the selected video. <div data-bbox="326 1262 532 1346" style="text-align: center;">  </div>
25.	End of Procedure.
