

Set Up of Android G1 and G2 with Google Mail

Step	Action
1.	Delete the settings for the Google account that is currently set up on your device.
	Click Settings.
	Click Applications.
2.	Clear the data for Gmail, Gmail Storage, and Google Apps.
	To about the data alight on the name of the application and alight the Clear data button
2	To clear the data check on the name of the application and check the Clear data button.
3.	A sign on screen will appear.
	Type your CaseID followed by @case.edu in the Username field.
	Type your Google password in the Password field.
	Click <mark>Sign in</mark> .
4.	The message, "Your email will appear shortly" appears on the screen.
	Click the Back button .
	Go to Settings.
	Go to Synchronization.
5.	The Synchronization screen will appear.
	Click the Auto-sync option to turn it off.
	Select the following options:
	Mail, Calendar and Contacts.
	A rotating sync symbol will appear next to each item you selected, and your 3G data arrows at the top should light up.
6.	After the sync has finished, you can Click Auto Sync , to turn this feature back on. If you do, then Google will sync these items again.
7.	You can now set up your Case Google Mail on your device.
	The following instructions are assuming that you do not have any mail accounts set up on the device.

Step	Action
8.	Go the the Inbox Application.
	The Welcome screen appears.
	Click Next.
9.	In the email address field, enter your CaseID followed by @case.edu.
	In the Password field enter your Case Google Mail password.
	Click the Next button.
10.	The Settings screen appears.
	Select IMAP Account
	Enter the following information in the incoming settings:
	Username: your CaseID followed by @case.edu
	Password: your Google password
	IMAP server: imap.gmail.com
	Security Type: SSL (always)
	IMAP path prefix: None
11.	Click Next
	Enter the following information in the outgoing settings:
	Server: smtp.gmail.com
	Port: 465
	Require sign-in: Yes (Checked)
	Username: Your caseID followed by @case.edu
	Password: Your Google password
12.	Click Next
	The phone will check the outgoing settings.
13.	On the account options screen, choose your preferred settings for these options.
	Click Next
14.	Enter a name for your account and enter your name.
	Click Done.
	Email should appear shortly on your screen.
15.	This completes the process of setting up your Android G1 or G2 phone to use Case Google
	Mail.
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
