- Zoom is a communications software that combines video conferencing, online meetings and mobile collaboration
- Zoom account not required for Zoom meetings guests
- Think of it as a virtual conference room

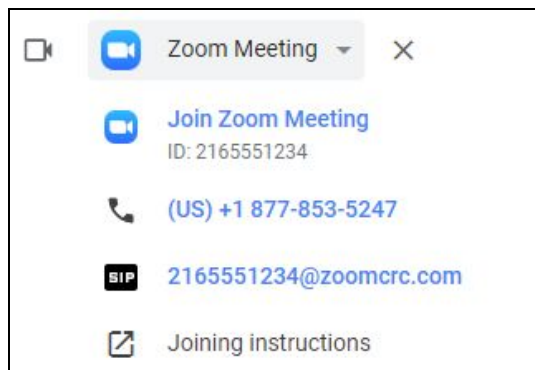
## Joining Instructions For A Zoom Meeting

Each includes links to click on to join from a laptop, tablet, or smartphone. There is also the option to attend via a traditional telephone line.

Each invite also shows a 9 or 10 digit number, known as the Meeting ID. It is unique to that meeting. In the top example, the Meeting ID number is 592674671, as shown in the link <https://cwru.zoom.us/j/592674671> and under the telephone instructions. In the bottom example, the Meeting ID is 2165551234, as shown below the "Join Zoom Meeting" link.

## Join a Zoom Meeting

To join a Zoom meeting, use the link or information for your device.

When joining from a laptop, tablet or smartphone, Zoom will require a small app be installed on the device. This is a one time download and is not required for future Zoom meetings using that device.
