



## Crafters@Case

Established in 2013, **Crafters@Case** is a diverse group of staff, students, and faculty from Schools of Nursing, Engineering, MSASS, Research Administration, and multiple departments in the School of Medicine. **Everyone is welcome** regardless of skill level. There are no dues/fees. The group is free to choose to create hats, scarves, and other items for donation, or work on personal projects.

Each January the group votes to determine which organizations should be given donations. Items are also created for sale to raise funds for organizations that feed the homeless and needy. In 2020 the Crafters donated 137 items to **Providence House**, 106 items were donated to **Laura's Home** in 2021, 84 items were donated to **City Mission** in 2022, and 60 items were donated in 2023 (26 to **Sister Haven** and 34 to **Norma Herr Women's Center**).
